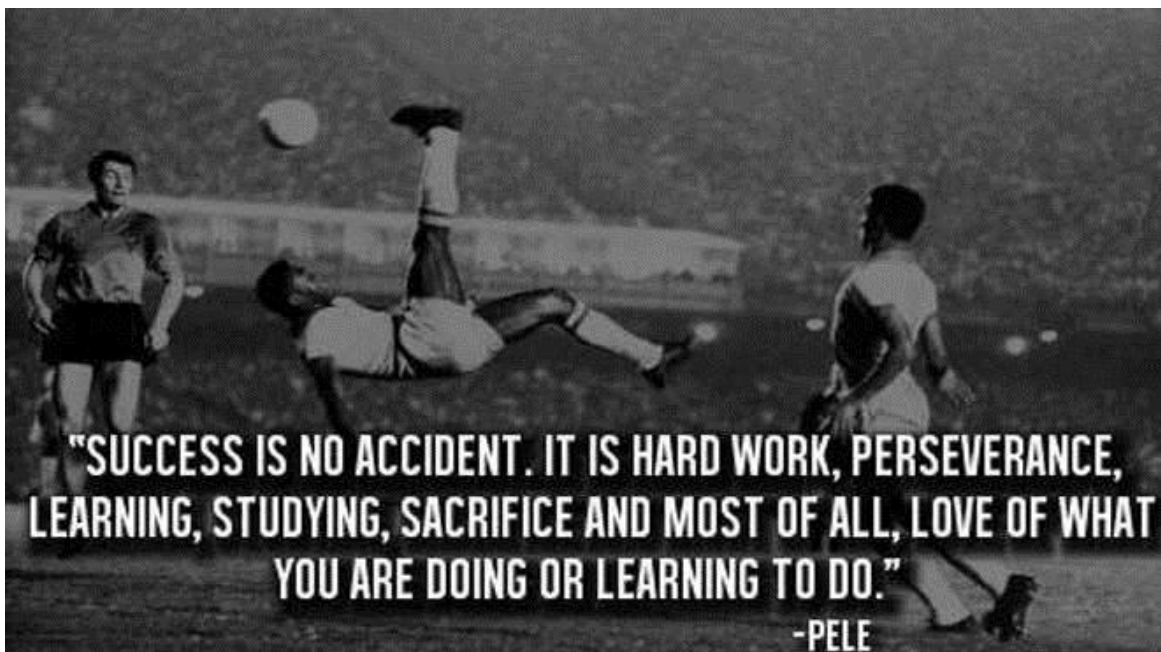

to hold a NRPP basic measurement certification. State licensing is not a substitute)
