Volunteers report to the Capitol Building in Topeka from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. treating legislators, staff and visitors who need medical attention. **Please note that the parking FDOD space has changed to #A-169 in the Statehouse underground parking garage.** The number of patients seen varies and volunteers use open time to catch up on emails and phone calls.
