All NAPT certified members must maintain a continuous annual NAPT membership, as well as achieve a minimum number of points, **see point accumulation chart**, in order to retain their certified status. The points must be accrued and submitted along with this form and a payment of \$25. Each certified member has a period of three (3) years to earn the commensurate amount of points for their certification, beginning on the last day of the month of the original certification or last prior recertification. You may attach any necessary accompanying documents to this form.

Specialists must accumulate ten (10) points in the last three (3) years.
Supervisors must accumulate twenty (20) points in the last three (3) years.
Directors must accumulate thirty (30) points in the last three (3) years.
