

Version Three of the CP³R Now Available

The latest version of the [Cancer Program Practice Profile Reports \(CP³R\)](#) has been posted with the following features:

- Data are displayed for diagnosis years 2009, 2010 and 2011.
- Three new breast measures have been added. (See more information at <http://www.facs.org/cancer/qualitymeasures.html>.)
- Registrars can edit codes that affect whether or not the case belongs in the denominator of the measures, replacing the function of the former “censor” button.
- Navigation is simplified, and both facility and comparison performance rates update when changes are made.
- Documentation is improved; see <http://www.facs.org/cancer/ncdb/cp3r.html>

The underlying data for the original measures have not changed, but some differences in performance rates and numbers of cases may have resulted from the following modifications:

- Malignant Phyllodes tumor (M9020) histology is no longer eligible for any of the current breast measures
- All eligibility criteria are measure-specific, so the category “Not Applicable to Any Measure” no longer exists
- Revised time passage calculations move cases with incomplete dates (typically unknown day) to the “incomplete” category unless the month and/or year are identifiable within the expected treatment window
- Cases that were formerly “censored” are excluded from CP³R (v3), so the number of cases may decrease from version 2
