TEXAS ASSOCIATION OF BUILDERS NAMES EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

(AUSTIN, TX) November 12, 2008 – The Texas Association of Builders announced that M. Scott Norman, Jr. has taken the seat of Executive Director. Norman was named as Executive Director for the association of over 12,000 statewide members and associates after serving as Interim Executive Director for the past nine months. In his new role, he will continue to lead the government relations and political activities of the association as well as manage the third largest builders association in the nation.

Norman has been actively involved in state government for over 12 years as both a Capitol staffer and a lobbyist. Prior to joining the Texas Association of Builders in January of 2003, Scott Norman served as a staff attorney for Texas State Senator J.E. "Buster" Brown, and as General Counsel for the Texas Senate Natural Resources Committee and the Texas Council of Engineering Companies, Inc.

He is a member of the Construction Law section of the Texas Bar Association, the Travis County Bar Association and the Austin Young Lawyers Association.

Scott Norman received his Bachelor of Arts in Economics from University of Texas at Austin and received his Doctor of Jurisprudence from South Texas College of Law in May of 1996. He is married to Austin lawyer Monique Milisci Norman. The couple has two sons.
