DP World commenced operations at Port Rashid, Dubai in 1972 and has grown and now has 150 operating sites around the world.

Canadian Stevedoring Limited was founded in 1923 with the mission of serving BC's marine industry. These origins make it the oldest Canadian-owned stevedoring company still in existence today. In 1968, subsidiary Casco Terminals established and became the terminal operator of Centennial Pier (Centerm), now DP World Vancouver's current site.

DP World (Canada) commenced operations in 2006 when it acquired P&O Ports (Centerm) and evolved to became one of the top marine terminal operators in the world. In August 2015, DP World acquired Maher Terminal's Fairview Container Terminal (Fairview) in Prince Rupert, British Columbia, expanding its presence in the Canadian market. Today, DP World operates port terminals in Vancouver (Centerm), Prince Rupert, Nanaimo Island, Fraser Surrey Docks, and Saint John. "With current and future expansion projects underway, Canada will continue to play an important role in enabling global trade and being a vital partner within the DP World Organization", said Tabare Dominguez, Commercial Director.
