

TC, NavCan conducting aeronautical study at CYPQ

At a recent meeting held at Peterborough airport (CYPQ), it was revealed that Transport Canada and Nav Canada are conducting a service review in light of perceived increase in air traffic due to the arrival of the Seneca College operation at CYPQ.

Based on recent aircraft movements at the former home of Seneca College (Buttonville), 28,000 per year was a figure quoted during the meeting. There will be a notice coming out soon saying where Seneca College will have their training area and possibly transit routes to and from that area. This meeting was the information phase of the study.

There are other factors that will also be considered in the study, one being jet traffic.

Transport Canada and Nav Canada are now asking for input. Let them know if you have experienced any problems flying in or out of CYPQ.
