The Burton L. Roslyn, FAIA Memorial Scholarship

The AIA New York State (AIANYS) Emerging Professionals Committee developed a scholarship program to encourage participation in the Architect Registration Examination (ARE). This scholarship is intended to recognize Associate AIA members in New York State who have made significant contributions at an early stage in their careers to the profession and to encourage their pursuit of licensure.

In 2020, the Scholarship was rebranded in recognition of Burton L. Roslyn, FAIA, who spent much of his career mentoring and educating emerging architects. In his role as educator at New York Institute of Technology and as a Professional, he trained, mentored and educated his students, emerging professionals and peers all with the vision of elevating the Architect's role in creating the built environment.

Two recipients received scholarships of \$1,410 each to cover the total cost of the exams. The recipients are **Chitra Mamidela, Assoc. AIA** and **Peter Hsi, Assoc. AIA**, both from the Brooklyn Chapter.

In addition to the Burton L. Roslyn scholarship, the John A. Notaro Memorial Scholarship was also awarded. AIANYS, in partnership with the AIA Component Matching Scholarship Program, sponsors the annual awards and encourages the participation of New York State's Schools of Architecture to recognize our future leaders in architecture.

Out of 13 applications, three projects were selected to receive awards and each student will receive \$500 to use towards their tuition— **Seung Hyo Chang**, for the project CORE - THE CENTER OF DIVISION; **Violet Wen** for The Space Capsule; and **Ryo Ishioka & Shiori Green** for Community Circuit.
