PRESENTATION ABSTRACT

Metal Earth is a large multidisciplinary research project managed by the Mineral Exploration Research Centre at Laurentian University and includes 5 additional university research groups. The project is focused on understanding the processes that result in differential metal endowment in Precambrian terranes. This presentation will focus on new geophysical and geological interpretation of full crustal sections (transects) across ancestral fault systems and, volcanic and intrusive centres in the southern Abitibi and Wabigoon sub-provinces and how these features relate to gold mineralization.
