These cards are a communication tool to assist with history taking, assessment and explanation of treatments, procedures or discharge instructions. The 17 cards are attached to a ring clip and use emojis or illustrations to explain a particular topic or aspect of medical care. The cards are made of durable material that can be cleaned and used with a dry erase marker. Communication cards are ideal for use by EMS, emergency triage, ongoing ED or hospital care and for patient interviews.
