The American Academy of Family Physicians (AAFP) is recruiting 25 family medicine practices for the Adult Immunization Office Champions Project. The three-and-a-half-year project aims to provide effective tools and strategies for developing a culture that promotes adult immunizations.

WHY PARTICIPATE?

The project will focus on the following key areas:

- Improve the use of a provider's strong recommendation to adult patients.
- Ensure immunization assessment and documentation in patient medical records.
- Reduce missed opportunities to immunize adult patients.
- Increase adult immunization data submissions to the state and local Immunization Information Systems (IIS).
- Implement evidence-based practices to improve adult immunization coverage.
- Improve collaboration and data exchange among other adult immunization providers.

ELIGIBILITY AND PROJECT REQUIREMENTS

Selected participants must be:

- An AAFP active member
- A practicing family physician (family medicine residencies may apply, but residents cannot serve as the physician champion)

RECOGNITION AND COMPENSATION

The selected practices that participate and complete the AAFP Adult Immunization Office Champions Project will receive \$3,000 to help defray administrative costs.
