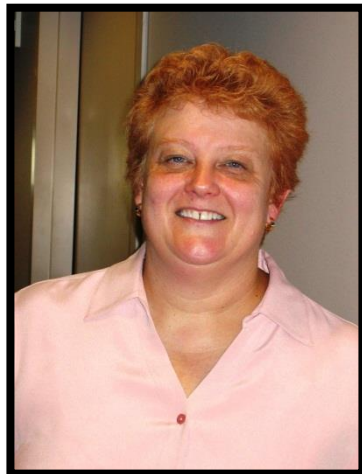

Carol Havens, MD, is the Director of Clinical Education at the Kaiser Permanente Medical Care Program, Northern California Region, and also a staff physician of Chemical Dependency and Recovery Program at Kaiser Permanente. She is board certified in Family Medicine, and is certified in Addiction Medicine by examination from the American Society of Addiction Medicine. Dr. Havens received an undergraduate degree in Medical Technology from Michigan State University and her medical degree from the University of Arizona. She completed her residency training at the University of California, Davis-Sacramento Medical Center Family Practice Residency Program.

Over the course of her career, Dr. Havens has held various leadership positions including President of the California AFP (CAFP) in 2011. She is current Chair of the CAFP CME & CPD committee, past chair of the California Medical Association CME committee, a member of the Accreditation Review Committee for the ACCME, and a member of the CME committee for the Permanente Federation and Audio-Digest.

Dr. Havens has been published in more than 15 peer-reviewed journals and other publications, and is the recipient of CAFP Foundation's 2009 Barbara Harris Award for Educational Excellence.
