

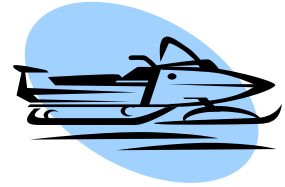

7th Annual Ride For Kids Friday, February 26th 2016



The Electrical Association of Manitoba invites you to attend the 7th Annual MEL Snowmobile Ride for Kids. Come out and enjoy a fun ride along with your fellow Sledheads in the industry in supporting this amazing cause.

This year we will be raising funds to help grant the wish of 14 yr. old "Reese"

Reese is an energetic, avid sports lover, like most 14 year old boys his age. He loves the Winnipeg Blue Bombers and his favourite color is blue. He loves to listen to Florida Georgia Line and his favorite TV show is the Simpsons. As a sports fanatic, his favorite class in school is physical education. Reese also has Cystic Fibrosis (CF).

With this disease, Reese often has to take time away from playing sports with friends to avoid getting sick and has to try much harder to keep up in gym class. Despite the disease, Reese still continues to push himself to play the top level of sports because he doesn't want CF to control his life.

Reese's wish is to attend the world biggest sporting event in the world, the 2016 Summer Olympics. Every two years when the Olympics come around, the family sits together and watches the events and his dream is to be able to watch them live. Some of the events he would like to see are Volleyball, especially Beach Volleyball, Basketball (team USA and) track and field.

With the unknowingness of Reese's future and the families' busy schedule, Reese thinks this would be a perfect opportunity to take his first trip and enjoy sports with the family.

The ride will start and finish at Falcon Lake. The total ride length is app. 150 miles, but a smaller loop is available for those who wish to ride less (app. 120 miles). The ride is not a race or poker derby; it is strictly a fund raiser for the Children's Wish Foundation.

- ***Carry a 1st Aid Kit***
- ***Use proper hand signals***
- ***Have a rendezvous/check-in plan in case someone gets lost in your group***

RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY,

ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT FOR ELECTRICAL ASSOCIATION OF MANITOBA

IN CONSIDERATION of the use of snowmobiles for the purpose of this fund raising event, from the date hereof and for any and all dates thereafter, for any and all purposes and activities including, without limitation, the operation, maintenance, observation or use of snowmobiles or other motorized vehicles (hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Activities"), the undersigned, on his/her own behalf, and on behalf of his/her personal representatives, heirs, next of kin, and any and all other persons participating in the activities as a guest of the undersigned (hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Undersigned"):

1. Hereby **RELEASES, WAIVES, DISCHARGES AND COVENANTS NOT TO SUE** the directors, officers, agents and employees of **Manitoba Electrical League** (hereinafter referred to as "Releases"), from all liability to the Undersigned for any and all loss or damage, and any claim or demands therefore on account of injury to the person or property, **WHETHER CAUSED BY THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEES OR OTHERWISE.**

2. Hereby agrees to indemnify and **SAVE AND HOLD HARMLESS THE RELEASEES** and each of them from any loss, liability, damage, or cost they may incur arising out of or related to the Activities **WHETHER CAUSED BY THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEES OR OTHERWISE.**

3. Hereby **ASSUMES FULL RESPONSIBILITY** for any risk of bodily injury, death or property damage arising out of or related to the Activities **WHETHER CAUSED BY THE NEGLIGENCE OF RELEASEES OR OTHERWISE.**

4. Hereby **ACKNOWLEDGE THAT THE ACTIVITIES ARE VERY DANGEROUS** and involve the risk of serious injury and/or death and/or property damage.

5. Hereby agrees that this Release and Waiver of Liability, Assumption of Risk and Indemnity Agreement **EXTENDS TO ALL ACTS OF NEGLIGENCE BY THE RELEASEES**, and is intended to be as broad and inclusive as is permitted by the laws of the Province of Manitoba and that if any portion thereof is held invalid, it is agreed that the balance shall, notwithstanding, continue in full legal force and effect.

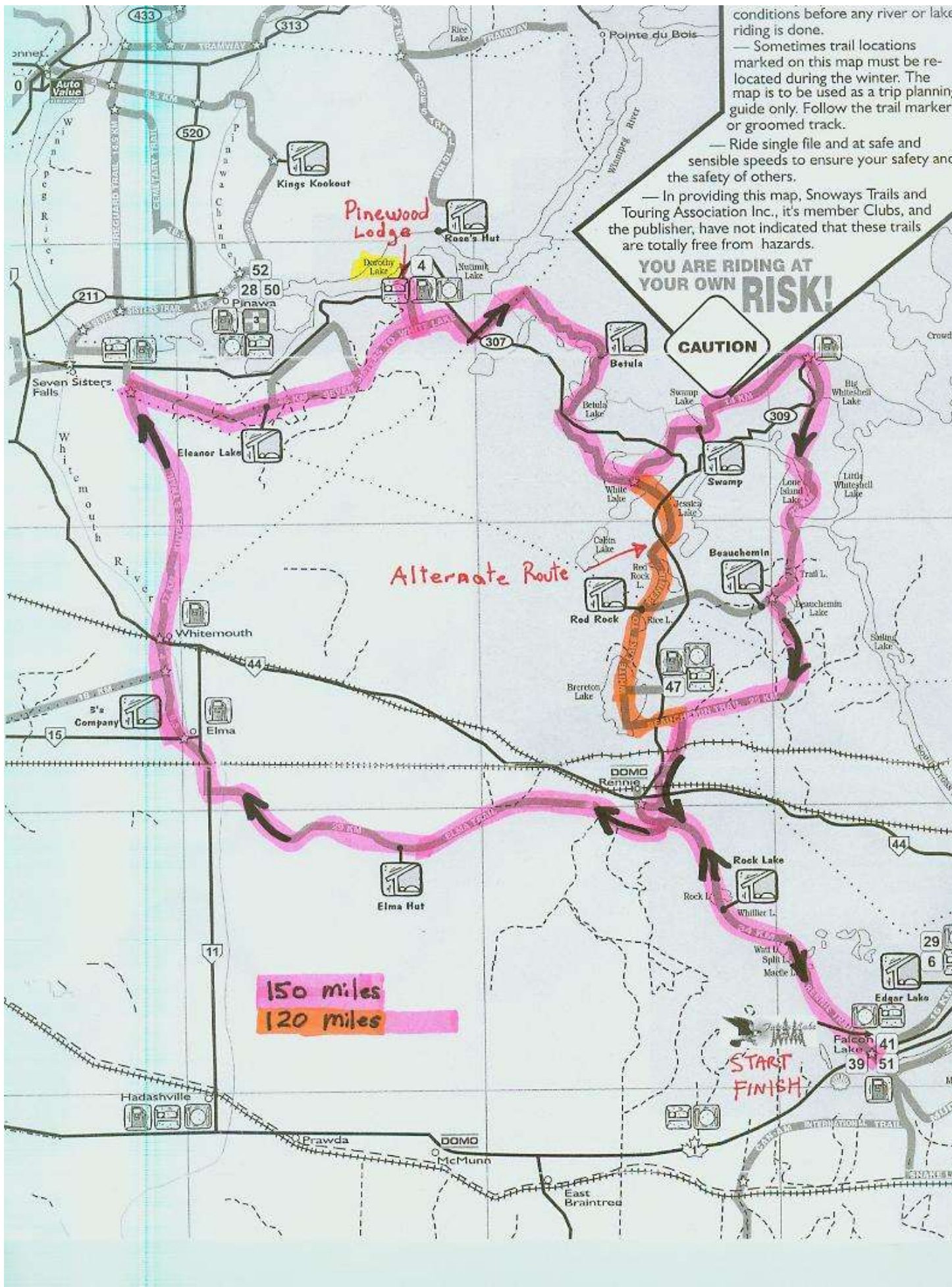
