Jetline Issues Recall On Power Adaptor

Supplier Jetline (UPIC: jetline) in Gaffney, South Carolina, in cooperation with the U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC), has issued a voluntary recall for about 31,000 power adaptors. The adaptors can overheat and pose a burn hazard when in use. So far, one injury has been reported due to the defect.

The recalled adaptors—plastic cubes with a two-pronged plug on one side and USB port on the other—can be used to charge cell phones and other electronic devices and feature the model number ADCP3-1000 printed on the plug-side of the adaptor. The Chinese-made adaptors were produced in five colors: black, blue, green, red and white—and distributed nationwide from October 2013 to April 2014.

Speaking to *PPB Newslink*, Teresa Fang, Jetline's director of purchasing, says, "We take our dedication to product safety very seriously at Jetline. We are vigilant in our pursuit of safety and compliance, and always choose the best path to protect both our distributor and end-user clients. We voluntarily reported this to the CPSC as a proactive means to take responsibility for a potential issue. We chose to address this head on and communicate proactively because the safety of our customer base is our top priority."

The CPSC states that consumers should immediately stop using the adaptors and dispose of them or make arrangements for their return.
